



## NOTIFICATION OF THE OFFICE OF THE ADMINISTRATIVE COURTS

RE: INTENT ON ADMINISTRATION IN GOOD FAITH OF OFFICE OF THE ADMINISTRATIVE COURTS

I, Mrs. Somridee Thanyasiri, Secretary-General of the Office of the Administrative Courts, together with executives of the Office of the Administrative Courts, Administrative Court officials, and personnel of the Office of the Administrative Courts, hereby declare our sincere intent that the Office of the Administrative Courts shall cherish the Sufficiency Economy Philosophy and working precepts of His Majesty King Bhumibol Adulyadej The Great and the First Royal Command given by His Majesty King Maha Vajiralongkorn Phra Vajiraklaochaoyuhua stating “I shall sustain, preserve and build upon the Royal Legacy, and shall reign with righteousness for the benefit and happiness of the people forever.”

All personnel of the Office of the Administrative Courts shall perform their duties and in accordance with the following principles so as to yield maximum benefit to the nation and the people:

1. To focus on achievement of work outcomes and to perform duties with honesty in accordance with principles of good governance and by not committing malpractices, actions based on self-interest, bribery or any other practice aimed at gaining illegal advantage;

2. To perform duties transparently by making practices open to examination; giving the public an opportunity to access and examine information on the operation of the Office of the Administrative Courts and by providing channels for public hearings and for lodging complaints;

3. To improve work methods and procedures and to provide standardized service in order that the public and those receiving services shall be able to easily, promptly, transparently and equitably access administrative justice; and

4. To promote work integrity and to educate personnel of the Office of the Administrative Courts in the Sufficiency Economy Philosophy and the Administrative Court Culture (TRUST) and not to tolerate any form of corruption.
