



Notification of Office of the Administrative Courts
on
No-Gift Policy for the Fiscal Year B.E. 2568 (2025)

Whereas the personnel of the Office of the Administrative Courts, in compliance with the principles of good governance, are required to perform their duties with righteousness and honesty, to refrain from exploiting their official duties for personal advantage or to engage in acts of corruption or create conflicts of interest as outlined in the Rule of the Commission of Officials of the Office of the Administrative Courts on the Code of Conduct for Personnel of the Office of the Administrative Courts, B.E. 2555 (2012), and in accordance with the Administrative Court TRUST values:

The Secretary-General hereby declares that all executives, officials, and both permanent and temporary employees of the Office of the Administrative Courts shall not accept any gifts or other forms of benefit, either before or after performing their official duties. This measure is intended to prevent corruption and malfeasance. The Office of the Administrative Courts further reaffirms its commitment to fostering and ensuring the adherence to shared values and the practice of righteous and transparent conduct within the organisation.
